

NOTICE OF AMENDMENT

Amendments to Singapore Air Safety Publication Parts 2 and 10

Please be informed that the following Singapore Air Safety Publication (SASP) have been amended:

- SASP 2 – Licensing of Professional Pilots
- SASP 10 – Approval of an Aviation Training Organisation

The changes in this amendment of the SASP 2 include:

- (a) removal of the period of validity of Airline Transport Pilot Licence (ATPL) examination results for the purpose of obtaining an ATPL;
- (b) inclusion of examination requirements for Singapore licence holders intending to obtain an aircraft rating but last flew an aircraft from 5 years ago or more;
- (c) removal of the pre-requisites to hold a valid aircraft rating and a medical certificate to be eligible to convert to a Singapore licence; and
- (d) update to the night flying experience requirements for pilots undergoing a CAAS approved course of training or converting from a foreign licence.

SASP 10 is amended correspondingly for item (d) above.

SASP 2 Issue 9 Amendment 5 and SASP 10 Issue 2 Amendment 7 come into effect on 22 December 2020 and can be found at the [CAAS website](#).
